Experience in inclusive education, with demonstrable expertise in the management of learners with a wide spectrum of learning barriers e.g. Autism spectrum disorders, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia, ADHD etc. Personal commitment and a willingness to contribute to the value and mission of Jan Kriel School is essential.

The successful candidate must have an ECD NQF Level 5 qualification **or** preferable a Teacher's Diploma **or** a B.Ed. Foundation Phase Degree. English and Afrikaans Home Language is a pre requisite as a medium for instruction. Experience in teaching grade R will be an advantage.

Knowledge of the CAPS curriculum, how to plan, control, record and report on assessments is required. E-Lit training and experience in group work would be an advantage. Applicant must be SACE registered or have of receipt of application.
